Communion paraments box
(kept to the right under the altar)

(the pale blue box, remove 3 purificators with the small red cross)

Baptismal supplies
(contains baptismal towels,
shell, etc.)



Corporal placed on the
altar for communion
(about 16" x 16"
plain square)



Chalices then are placed on the corporal



Two purificators are placed on chalices.



The stiffened square pall placed over purificators



Setting Veil over the pall.
(note how to line-up the front edge with the fold the veils should be ironed flat with no creases)



The third purificator is placed in the burse.



A large celebration host is put on top of small wafers on paten.
